

Counselors-in-Training are 13, 14 and 15 year olds who have come to Strong River as a camper and want to continue coming to camp and are willing to take on some of the responsibilities of the staff. Many 13 year olds choose to return for one more year as a camper. This is great! We want you to enjoy being a camper for as long as possible.

Junior Counselors are 16, 17 and 18 year olds who have been outstanding campers and C.I.T.s and are invited back to help the counselors and to learn more about what it means to be a leader at Strong River. The C.I.T.s and Junior Counselors are all part of the Junior Staff.

After each session we hold a staff meeting to evaluate Junior Staff and potential C.I.T.s for the next summer. Your acceptance on the Junior Staff is partially based on your performance from the previous summer. We have many more eligible Junior Staff than we have places available so please send in your application as soon as possible. **This year, applications for Junior Staff spots are due by January 10, 2025.**

You have probably observed the Junior Staff setting tables in the dining room, loading canoes, helping the counselors at activities and being friends to the campers. You will make a transition from being a camper who enjoys camp to being a part of the staff who creates the great atmosphere for the campers. You will have the fun of leading the campers in the "Strong River Way." You'll need to smile, be positive, be energetic, and be helpful.

Be sure to indicate the activities you'd like to help teach on your application. You may rotate to more than one activity during the week. **All Junior Staff need to write a letter each year explaining why you want to be on the Junior Staff.** We feel it is important for you to evaluate your feelings about camp so you can consider what it is you want to contribute. This letter is due by January 10, 2025.
